Authors interested in applying for their book(s) to be considered for this activity should follow the instructions available on the website of the conference at <http://www.iuhpeconference.net/> and **send their application by no later than December 31st 2009.**

Instructions:

At its 20th World Conference, the IUHPE would like to provide the participants with the opportunity to meet with authors of the latest books in the field, published since its last World Conference, and purchase these books onsite.

To be considered, books should:

- **have been published after June 2007** (books submitted for publication or in print but not physically available at the time of the conference are not eligible);
- **be in one of the official languages of the conference** (English, French, Spanish plus German);
- **cover topics in the fields of Health Promotion, Health Education** or, exceptionally given the theme of the Geneva Conference, of **Sustainable Development**;
- come with an understanding **that the author(s) will attend the conference at their own expenses.** The authors will also be willing to participate in a 'Meet the authors!' exchange of about 90 minutes with a maximum of about 20 delegates, facilitated by a graduate student, to be held at breakfast time during the Conference. For edited or multi-authored books, several authors can be present. Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to invite and confirm the presence of co-authors.

If you wish to apply, please send an e-mail to the person in charge of this activity, Dr. Michel O'Neill, at Michel.Oneill@fsi.ulaval.ca no later than December 31st 2009. Applications will be reviewed by an international multilingual committee and decisions announced by February 2010. In the message submitting the application please include: **title, author(s), term and year of publication**, as well as **all author(s) to be present at the activity**; including a **300-word maximum paragraph** explaining how the book could be useful to Health Promotion, Health Education or Sustainable Development communities. Moreover, a file containing a scan of **the cover page** of the book submitted along with the **cataloguing information page** (ISBN number should be provided) and the **table of contents** should be attached to the application e-mail. If the book has been reviewed, please attach a second file including a scan of the review(s).
