



## Global Working Group on Health Impact Assessment – Outline of a Work Plan

- The development of an IUHPE Position Paper on HIA, sharing best practice across the world, defining what is an HIA and what it is not, as well as the links between HIA and EIA. You mentioned earlier that you were hoping to include a consultative survey of HIA practitioners/2 round Delphi process as part of the development of this position paper;
- An update of the IUHPE existing brochure on HIA based on this Position Paper and a comprehensive dissemination of it;
- The organization of a Sub-Plenary on HIA to be submitted to the Global Scientific Committee of the IUHPE 22nd World Conference on Health Promotion which will take place in Curitiba, Brazil, on May 22-26, 2016. This particular item is being addressed through the Global Scientific Committee (GSC) of the World Conference.
- An update of the Guest co-edition of a special issue of the IUHPE peer-reviewed Journal Global Health Promotion on HIA (Ben Harris-Roxas and Monica O'Mullane guest editing);
- Pursuing the development of a repository of best practices, which is being led by Louise St Pierre (National Collaborating Centre for Healthy Public Policy);
- Fostering and strengthening links with other organizations such as the International Association for Impact Assessment (IAIA);
- Revising the HIA GWG webpage on the IUHPE website where all tools and resources from this program should be readily available, including links with existing portals and/or sites at IUHPE institutional partners.
